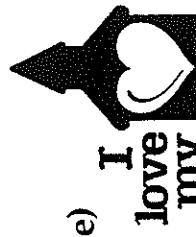

FROM YOUR PASTOR

February is "You Are Loved" Month" at Fayetteville's First Baptist Church. Now is the time to start inviting unchurched people to First Baptist Church. Over and over again studies done by the Home Mission Board of our Convention, The Gallup organization, and by Bama Research Group show that people who are unchurched start attending a particular church because someone they know invites them.

One Gallup study says that people are more positive about accepting invitations from their friends and acquaintances now than they were ten years ago. Nearly six out of ten people will give an invitation serious consideration.

Bama's Group says that when they asked unchurched people what it would take to get them to attend church, they responded by saying, "If a friend invited me."

Simply inviting people to Sunday School and worship is certainly not the sum of our responsibility, but it is a start. It is something even the most shy can do. Invite someone you know to Sunday School this week, and then introduce them around when they come. Encourage others in your family to invite someone. Encourage your children to invite someone.

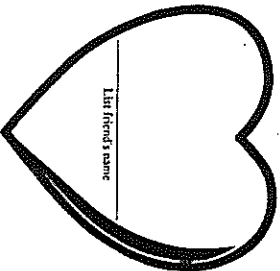
