"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

Over the past 2 1/2 years, God has done some really incredible things in the life of our youth ministry. We have seen many students come to know the Lord. We have seen many grow in their faith, and some share their faith with others. We have seen many make decisions to answer a call to vocational Christian ministry.

But, if there is one regret that I have in regard to ministry to students, it is that we have not given them a chance to take their faith to "the ends of the earth." Well, this summer will afford us that opportunity.

On July 4-13, 1997 our High School Ministry (completed 10th - 12th grade) will take a mission trip to Raleigh, North Carolina. We will be going through a co-ed missions group based out of the Brotherhood Department called **World Changers**. Our students will work on roofing and painting houses of elderly and poor families in Raleigh. They will also share in worship times with other youth groups from around the nation and will have the opportunity to share their faith with the lost.

To prepare for the trip they will commit to go through a six week preparation course, participate in a local missions project, and faithfully commit to pray for the trip. This trip is open to only 12 students. They must be believers and must fill out an application form in order to register to go. This form will ask for information concerning themselves as well as their personal testimony.

So what can you do as a congregation to help these young people take the message of Christ across our country? Well, one of the goals that we have set is to have the entire trip paid for so that the students will still have the opportunity to go to **Discovery Week Youth Camp** two weeks later. The cost of the missions trip is \$240 per student. This will provide for everything except spending money for the trip. We will need to raise \$3600 for all 12 students and 3 adult leaders to go on the trip. We are using two different ways to raise money for the trip. First, we will be accepting any scholarships that you may want to give toward the trip. These can be either partial or full scholarships as the Lord leads you to give. Second, we will be having two fund raisers before the trip. We will be doing a car wash and an all-church garage sale. The dates and times for these fund raisers have not been set yet. If you would be willing to help in any way, such as providing scholarships, towels, soap, etc...for the car wash, or your most quality junk for the garage sale, please let me know as soon as possible.

God is raising up a new generation to boldly take His message to every corner of this earth. Will you covenant with me to pray for this trip, these teenagers, and for the people of Raleigh, that God would move in a powerful way in our midst. Thanks so much for your prayers and your support of the Youth Ministry of Fayetteville's FBC. God bless.

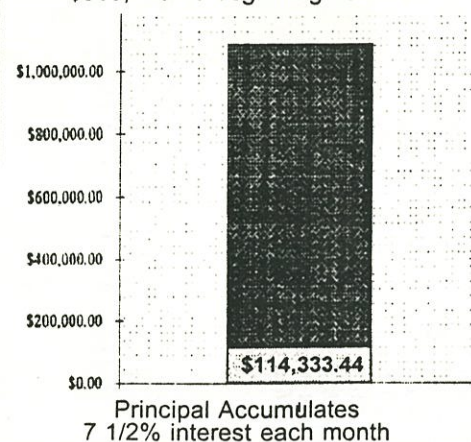
