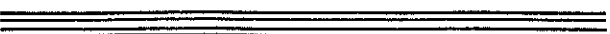
## From the Pastor's Pen

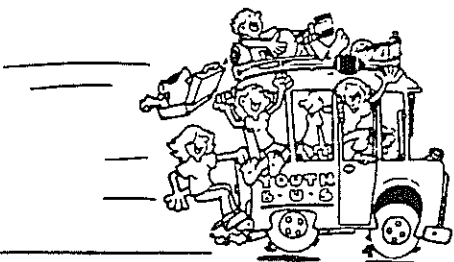
I'll look for you this Sunday in Sunday School.

You will need money for 2 meals, money for ice skating, and spending money. You also must have a completed permission form with you. (They are available in the church office.)

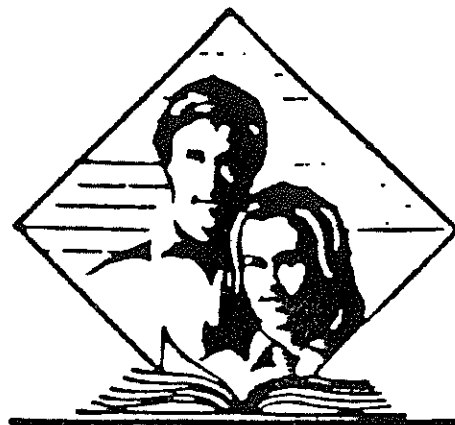


## HERE'S HOPE FIVE MOST WANTED



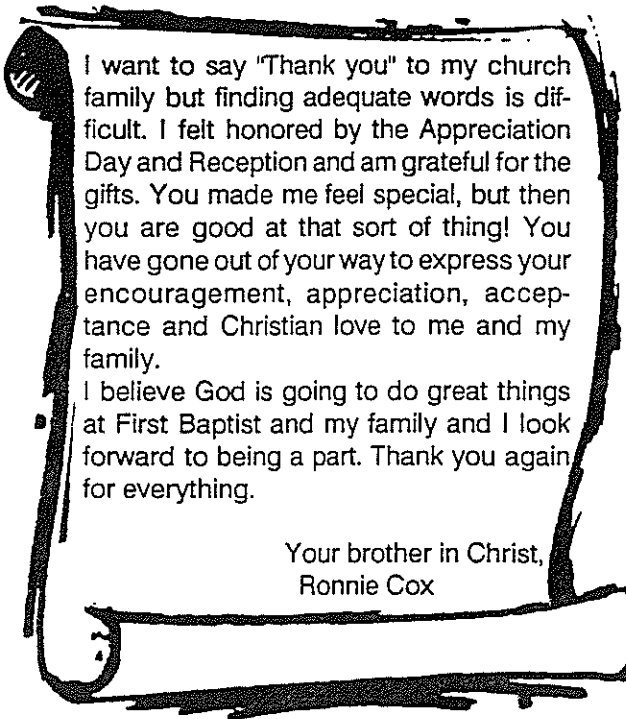
### The Challenge:

Film "A Story of Spain" at the Continuing Education Center. The cost is \$3.50 unless you have passport series.

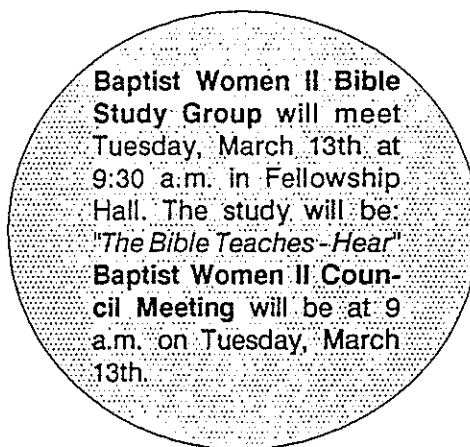
