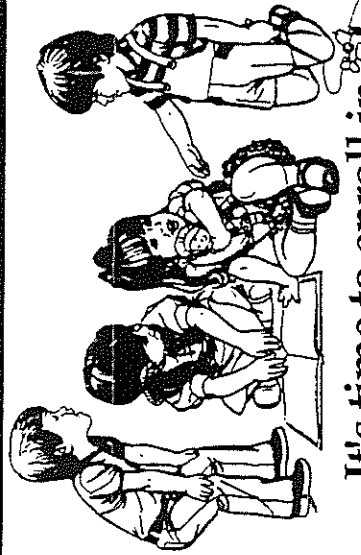

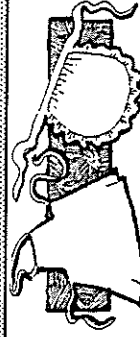

of two mornings.

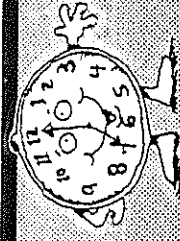
Some classes fill quickly,

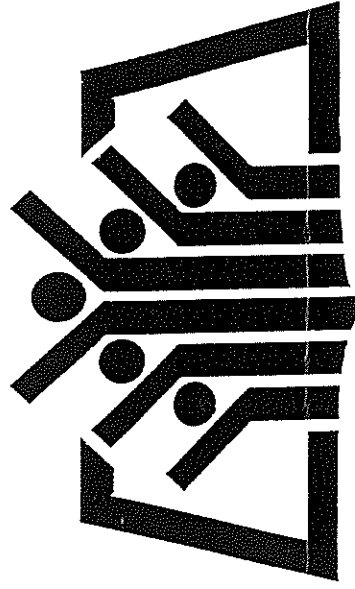
