

The Youth Culture


Where are all the youth?

According to the Census Bureau, the number of Youth ages 13 - 18 has declined from 21.9 million to approximately 20 million in the past 5 years. That now makes this the time of the lowest percent of young people ages 13 - 18 in our history. Youth currently make up between 7 & 8% of the total population. What does that mean? It means we must redouble our efforts to reach youth. The days of the huge number of youth just dropping into your group are gone. We must go find them and take Christ's message to them.
