

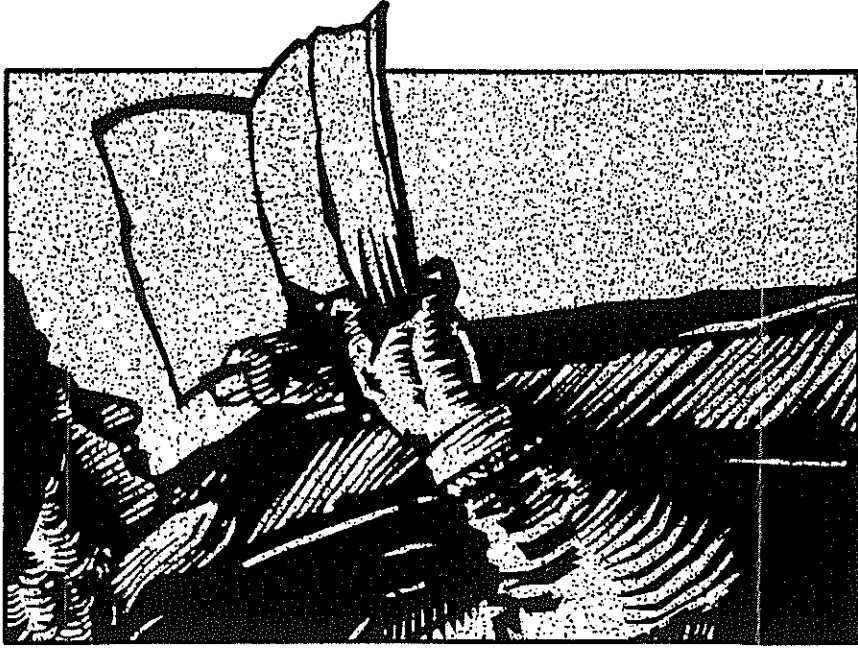

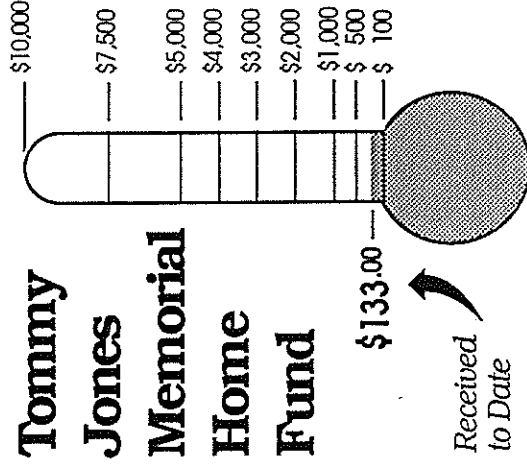

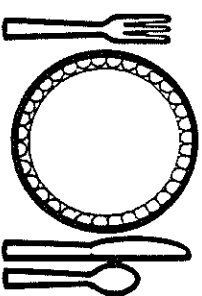
Please Call the Church Office When...
