

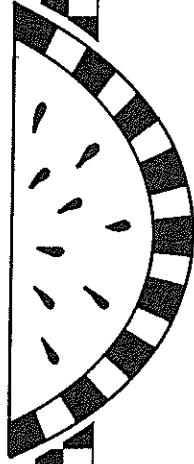

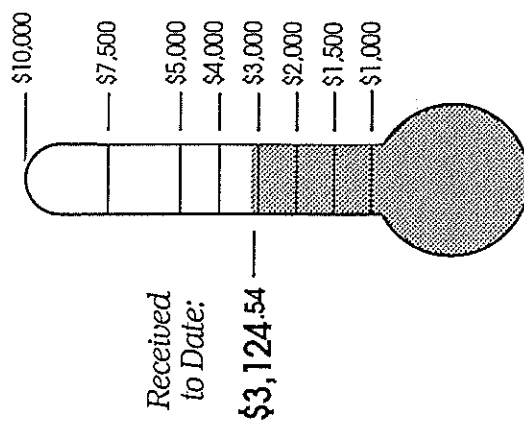

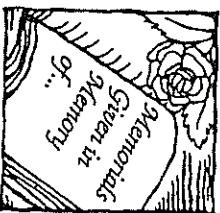
### Branson, Missouri - 8 AM, Sept. 14 to 8 PM, Sept. 15
