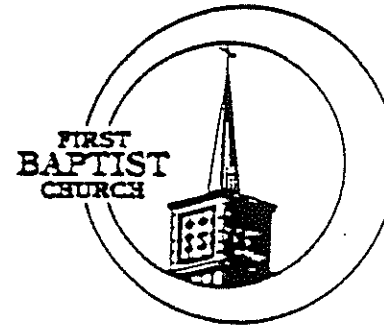

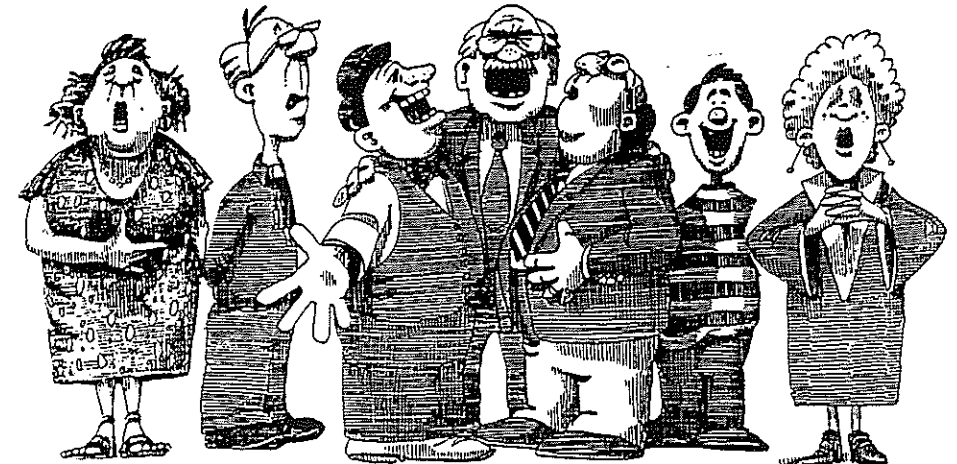

Music Ministry

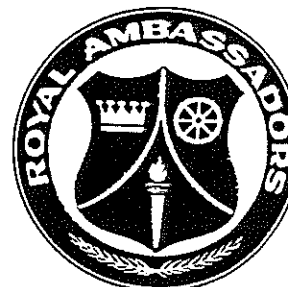
