...you learn of a death in the church family so that our ministers may be notified.

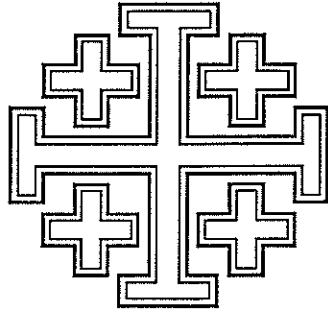
...your department, class, group or committee plans to have a meeting so that it can be cleared and placed on the church calendar.

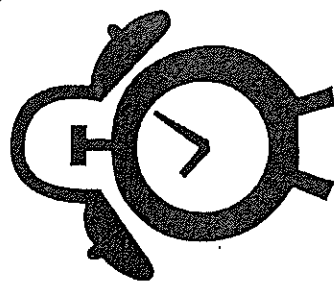

Something to think about...

I've been seeing a lot of print recently concerning "hand clapping" and saying "amen". It's a shame to see people pitting the two separate forms of worship expression against each other. In the New International Version (NIV), the word "amen" occurs in 72 verses. It means "be it assured", or "so be it". "Clap" or "clapping" appears in only 8 verses in the New International Version. The psalmist says in Psalm 47:1, "Clap your hands, all you nations, shout to God with cries of joy." It seems to me that both "amen" and "hand clapping" are viable forms of expression in worship.
