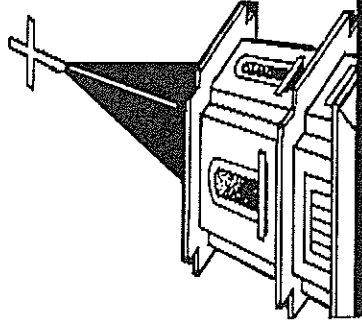

# the pastors' paragraphs

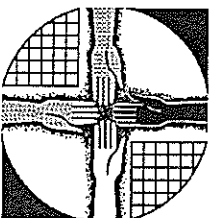
This is certainly a busy time of the year. Football season is in full swing. Baseball play-offs are going on. Basketball is just around the corner.

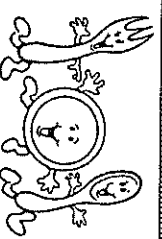
