Special Budget \$ Planning Edition

Over the past several months, the Stewardship Committee has been involved in the process of preparing the proposed 2015 budget. This requires collaboration with all church ministries and staff as they prepare and respond to the committee with budget needs. As always, First Baptist Church staff and ministry leaders were judicious in their efforts which has allowed the committee to prepare a proposed budget in which discretionary spending is approximately the same as the previous year. The Stewardship Committee supports the proposed 2015 Budget which is printed in this issue of the Voice.

This proposed budget represents a change in where debt reduction is reflected. This line item has been moved from section "Building and Equipment" to "Priority Giving" at the top of the budget, removing it from the calculation of budgeted receipts of other items in that category. Making this adjustment allows the budget to compare favorably with expected receipts. It is important for the Stewardship Committee to propose a faith-based budget which accurately reflects the expected receipts for the coming year.

The Stewardship Committee is looking forward to presenting the 2015 Budget Proposal with discussion in Sunday School department openings this Sunday and to the entire church during our Annual Church Conference on November 16, 2014. The vote to approve the 2015 Budget without discussion will be held Sunday morning November 23, 2014 during both services.

We praise God for the spirit of obedience and faithfulness to His direction that is guiding our church. The fruits of this spirit of obedience can be seen as you share your time, talent, actions and financial support all for His glory.

This committee appreciates your support, prayers and encouragement in this process. May God be glorified and His will be done.
