

## The Team Thing II

*Purpose: To provide a fun activity and Bible Study that our young people can and will invite their friends to.*

The **Team Thing** is a competition lasting four months in which each team competes for points. The team with the most points at the end of four months will win the Grand Prize, a trip to Tulsa to do whatever they want, eat whatever they want, etc. Points are awarded as follows:

1. Each team member present each Wednesday = 1000 points per week. (If a team member shows up on consecutive weeks, he gets 1000 points the first week, 2000 points the second week, 3000 points the third week, and so on. If he misses a week, he starts over at 1000 points.)
2. Each new team member = 5000 points.
3. Weekly team competition: First = 10,000 points; Second = 5,000 points; Third = 2,000 points.
4. There will be special award periodically with varying point amounts.

We will start out with five or possibly six teams (or more if you want). Team leaders are: **Team One** - Stacy Suvino; **Team Two** - Jeremy Moore; **Team Three** - Betsy Pendleton; **Team Four** - Christi Tanneberger; **Team Five** - Sarah Savage; **Team Six** - \_\_\_\_\_.

The **Team Thing** begins Wednesday, November 11, at 6:30 p.m. with a Mail Scavenger Hunt. Normally the **Team Thing** will run from 6:30 to 7:40 p.m., but on November 11 it will probably go until 8:00 p.m. Bring your friends! If you are not on a team, either join one or call me and tell me you want to start your own team (Team leaders will get special prizes and privileges during the contest!).


