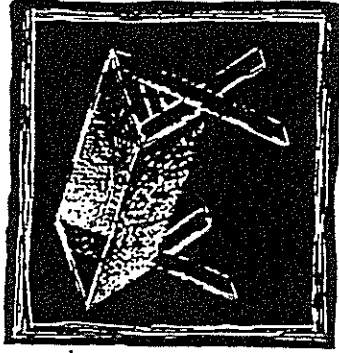

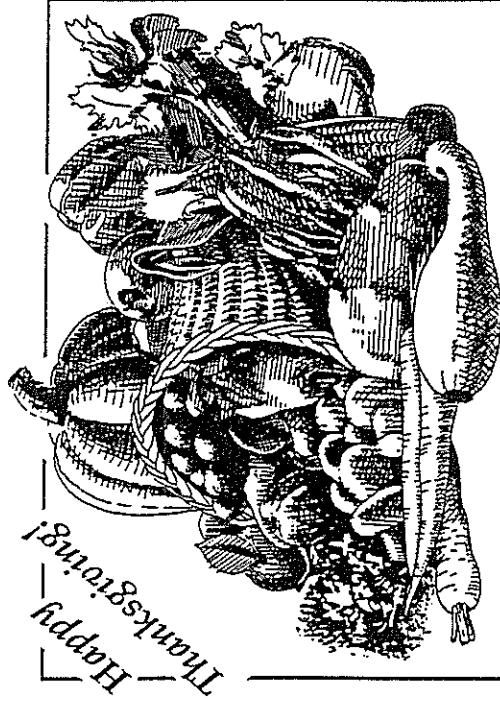

FROM YOUR PASTOR

Sunday begins the Week of prayer for Foreign Missions. It's always an important time as we focus on the work of our Foreign Mission Board and our missionaries. I urge you to attend the programs and services during this special emphasis. I also urge you to pray for our missionaries and their families and their work.

Sunday also begins our emphasis on the World Missions Offering. Our church voted to set our goal at \$-42,500. All money given to the World Missions Offering will be divided 65% for foreign missions, 20% for home missions, 10% for state missions, and 5% for local missions. Some of you give to some of these offerings during the year and want all of your offering to go to the Lottie Moon Offering. That is fine. If you wish the money divided some other way than the above formula, please indicate that when you give.

Also, please remember that these special offerings are intended to be over and above your regular offerings. If not, our budget giving suffers. Historically, December has been our best month as far as budget giving is concerned. I am praying that the Lord will give us a good month this December.

Monday night deacon-led visitation has been dropped for the month of December. An organized all-church visitation will be revived after the first of the year. In the mean time, keep talking to those you meet and those you know about Jesus and His church.

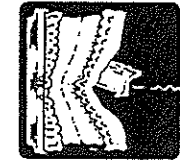
