



A girl born in Stigler, Oklahoma, changed the world. As a twelve year old, Jo developed a keen interest in Africa that would shape her future and put her on the path of being used by God in amazing ways to bring the Gospel of Jesus to those without hope in Nigeria. Though she passed away November 22, 2001

at the age of 90, her impact on missions and on First Baptist Church will continue to benefit the Kingdom of God.

Josephine Scaggs graduated from the University of Arkansas in 1935 (having served as the Baptist Student Secretary) and attended Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth. In 1939 the Foreign Mission Board (now the International Mission Board) of the Southern Baptist Convention appointed her as a missionary to Nigeria, British West Africa. Through her almost 40 years of mission work in Nigeria, Josephine Scaggs served as a teacher in the seminary and as an educational evangelical worker, established and built churches, schools, hospitals and pastor training facilities. Queen Elizabeth II decorated her as an honorary member of the Order of the British Empire.

Locally, her passion for missions inspired many people at First Baptist Church to take seriously our responsibility to reach our world with the Gospel of Christ. Through the years this church supported her with prayers, money, and care packages. We received much more in return: a individual and corporate commitment to be involved in missions.

It has been suggested that we establish a scholarship fund in memory of Josephine Scaggs to be used for the training of future Southern Baptist missionaries. This would allow her missions impact on First Baptist Church to grow through the years by preparing men and women to go to all the world with the message of Jesus. If you would like to see First Baptist Church establish this scholarship for missionaries, or if you would like to contribute to its support, please give me a call.


Everyone who is F.A.I.T.H. trained is encouraged to participate and to enlist one or two people to train during the Spring Semester.




