Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. 1 Peter 1:3

Holy Week has arrived, reminding us of our hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead! On Sunday (March 31) we will join our hearts and voices in exuberant celebration that Christ is risen from the dead, conquering sin and death.

As we prepare to celebrate, plans have been made to help us reach our city with the good news of Jesus and to prepare for the increased numbers of people who will worship on Easter morning. Thank you in advance for serving as the hands and feet of Jesus.

Here are specific ways you can serve:

1. Four community Easter egg hunts are planned for Saturday, March 30: Butterfield Elementary, Root Elementary, Salem Park, and Rodney Ryan Park in Stonebridge Subdivision. All of these will start at 10:30. Thank you for the many people who gathered last Sunday afternoon to pray while distributing invitations to our neighbors!

Thousands of plastic eggs with candy are ready for each location. Invite your neighbors, bring your children & grandchildren, enjoy the fun time, talk with neighbors, invite people to worship Easter morning. Crowds of people having fun will bring more people.

2. Easter morning will bring many people to our church campus who have never or rarely attended. Some of these folks will be out of town guests, some will be new residents, and some will be neighbors looking for a place to celebrate Easter. It is our joy and responsibility to help each person feel welcomed. This starts by greeting them in the (overcrowded) parking lot and continues by helping them navigate the entrances in order to find the sanctuary.

Sign-up to serve as a parking lot or door greeter. If you are physically able, please drop off your family at the church and park farther away, even remotely. The bank, behind ONF, the west end of Auto Zone, and the courthouse are great remote areas to park. Greet one another, including guests. Actively worship to encourage others: sing, pray, greet, give, listen, respond.

3. Pray. James 5:16 reminds us that "the prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." Our great longing, our desperate need, is for the Spirit of God to work in each of us. As we gather to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ, we will be joining with people from "the rising of the sun to its setting" in praise to the King of kings and Lord of lords. Let our hearts be prepared by seeking Him through fervent prayer.


