

## A. FUNDING

**1. What is the final projected cost of the new multipurpose worship center?**

*The Building Design Team (BDT) has set a budget of \$2.2 million.*

**2. How much funding is available at this time?**

*As of April 26, 2018, \$1.57 million.*

**3. Will \$2.2 million provide all necessary funds for a completely usable new multipurpose worship center?**

*No. Funds will still be needed for chairs, kitchen appliances, a sewer treatment system, and landscaping.*

**4. How much time is estimated before the full funding will be required?**

*Answer: Construction could be complete as soon as the second quarter of 2019.*

**5. Approximately what monthly contribution amount is needed to raise the funds to meet the anticipated completion date?**

*Using the answers from numbers 2 and 4 above, approximately \$50,000.*

**6. Can CrossPoint realistically raise these funds or will the Building Fundraising Team, at some point, need assistance from a capital fundraising firm?**

*Our own capital fundraising team has been hard at work. We are working with the contractor on phasing possibilities so that significant portions of the project can be completed with the funds available, resulting in some of the new space being immediately usable.*

## B. TIMELINE

**1. Will construction begin before we finish fundraising?**

*Yes*

**2. When will construction begin?**

*Our contractor will likely be ready to begin in the third quarter of this year.*

**3. Once we break ground, how long will construction take?**

*9 months to a year.*

## C. FACILITY

**1. Is the drawing displayed in the Worship Center the final design of the building?**

*Yes*

**2. Will the new building be connected directly to the current Children's Education Building (CEB)?**

*Yes*

**3. How many people will the building seat?**

*We are still planning for a maximum capacity of 375 to 400.*

**4. Will there be chairs or pews?**

*Chairs*

**5. Is a welcome center/coffee bar area planned for the new building?**

*Yes*

**6. Will the new building contain office space for pastors and staff?**

*No*

**7. Will there be a vestibule in the new building?**

*There will be a covering over as shown in the current design drawings. The space connecting the new Worship Center to CEB will be enclosed.*

**8. What amount of storage space will be provided in the new building?**

*Ample storage to support all aspects of worship and multi-purpose use is being planned.*

**9. Will a new covered drop-off area be provided?**

*Possibly. It is also possible that the current covered drop-off area can be reused. Final decisions have not been made on this.*

**10. Will we have a built-in, permanent baptistery in our new worship center?**

*Yes*

**11. Will there be changing rooms for those being baptized conveniently located in the new building?**

*Yes*

**12. Will there be new restrooms in the new building?**

*Yes*

**13. Will baby changing stations be included in the new restrooms?**

*Yes*

**14. Will the current restroom building be removed from the premises after construction is completed?**

**21. What is planned for the new kitchen?**

*2 cook tops, 2 double ovens, 2 deep sinks, 2 large refrigerators, stacked microwaves, warming drawers, an ice maker, an island, and a pantry.*

**22. Will the Food Pantry be moved to the new building?**

## D. LOGISTICS

**1. What buildings will stay and which buildings will be eliminated?**

*The Youth Dome must be dismantled to allow for construction of the new building.*

**2. Will the existing worship dome remain in place until the new facility is available for use?**

**3. If the Youth Dome must be eliminated, where will the youth meet?**

*This decision has not been made, but space will be made on campus for our youth.*

**4. Will our worship dome remain after the new building is complete?**

**5. What is going to happen to our youth dome?**

*There are contractors that dismantle sprung buildings at no cost in exchange for the materials. We plan to go this route.*

**6. How will parking be impacted during construction?**

*Like during any construction project, there will be inconveniences. Some of the parking closest to the project will likely be impacted.*

**7. Will any new parking be provided with this project?**

*Some new parking may be gained in reconfiguration of the driveways. We are not anticipating the need for a large amount of new parking at this point, but room exists on campus if that need is realized.*

**8. Will any existing parking be eliminated with this new construction?**

*Very minimal parking will be eliminated. Only a few of the spots directly adjacent to the Youth Dome and CEB will be impacted.*

## E. MOTHER'S DAY OUT

**1. How will the construction impact the Mother's Day Out Program?**

*There will certainly be construction related inconveniences for MDO, but construction will not stop the program.*

**2. What safety measures will be taken to ensure the children on campus are safe while construction crews are on site?**

*A formal plan is not yet in place, but our contractor is aware of our school. As we get closer to construction, we will work with the contractor and the city, fire marshal, etc., to ensure the safety of the children.*
