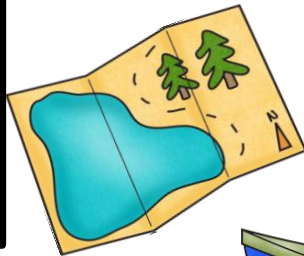
Session 1:

a Camp Out!

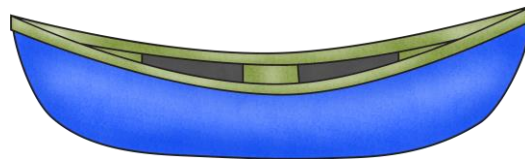

Lights Out!

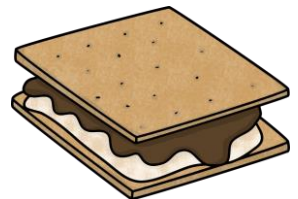

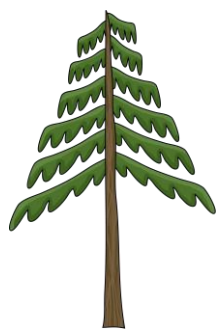


Fireflies - 3 years

**3
years**

Our youngest campers will be introduced to our camping theme through play based and sensory experiences. The classes for these age groups will use engaging stories, finger plays, and songs to introduce your children to literacy concepts like making predictions. Campers will also be using manipulatives to practice math concepts like sorting, counting, and finishing simple patterns. Of course no camping trip would be complete without plenty of time in mother nature playing, exploring, and learning!

**4
years**

The fearless four year-olds will explore the great outdoors daily with nature walks, observations, and plenty of time to play. They will also be engaged in math, literacy, and science activities that help them better understand the world around them. Campers will be working on sequencing events, counting groups of objects, learning letters, and expanding their creativity. The four year old courses will include art components to sharpen those fine motor skills.

**5-6
years**

The seasoned five year old campers will be exploring the great outdoors with a STEM perspective. They will use the scientific method to perform experiments, use technology to learn important facts, engineer their own tents and solar ovens, and use their mathematical brains to measure, add, and subtract! We won't forget to include some time for daily journaling and reading practice with captivating and age appropriate texts that will inspire your camper to read all summer long!
