YOUR STORY IS NEEDED!

1 – Story of the time God used something of yours that you had not thought could be used for anything other than it's "intended" purpose. This could be a possession, talent, etc. This could also be a story about a time when you felt inadequate to do something you believe God was calling you to do – you might have given in to your inadequacy or you said "yes" and God did a great work through that.

2 – A time when you were stuck in life and having a difficult time moving forward, didn't seem like there were a lot of options in moving forward, but instead of staying in stuck mode, you responded to God when He said "it's time to move forward!"

3 – Story of when you were overrun with fear, doubt, etc. and you went into retreat mode. And then God showed up in some way to remind you that His power is greater than that which was causing the fear, doubt, etc.
