QUESTIONS GOD ASKS US

1 – Story of the time God used something of yours that you had not thought could be used for anything other than it's "intended" purpose. This could be a possession, talent, etc. This could also be a story about a time when you felt inadequate to do something you believe God was calling you to do – you might have given in to your inadequacy or you said "yes" and God did a great work through that.

2 – A time when you were stuck in life and having a difficult time moving forward, didn't seem like there were a lot of options in moving forward, but instead of staying in stuck mode, you responded to God when He said "it's time to move forward!"
