Saturday, March 21, 2015

It's been a while since we've posted an update (we've been busy building the MSG), so here goes... We are now about 95% completed!

This past Saturday was our most recent Work Day and accomplished a lot!

We:

- Started building the LAST raised bed.
- Replaced the roof on the Garden Shed.
- Planted tomatoes, green peppers, hot peppers, and sunflowers.
- Harvested Cilantro and Parsley.
- Put blueberries into pots.
- Weeded all of the raised beds.

Saturday, March 1, 2014

Currently, the MSG is about 30% toward total completion.

Today was a beautiful day to have a MSG Work Day!

The day began with a bountiful breakfast supplied by Ardell.

95% of the weed blocking cloth was laid and pinned, a hand-washing station was built, and 4 Communal (Donation) beds were placed and filled with "Zoo-Doo."

Planting Sunday, March 9, 2014

Following worship services next week, the MSG will have its first planting. As a fitting symbol of this new and exciting ministry at Tims, mustard plants (grown from seeds) will be planted, along with other vegetables. Water from the Memorial Garden fountain, some of which came from the Jordan River, will be used for the Garden's first watering.
