



## Re-Gathering Guidelines

We are excited to re-gather as a church family to worship our Lord and build each other up in Him. We also trust that you are responsible to make wise decisions concerning your own health and safety, and that you will take precautions that you feel will keep you safe. Please be considerate of others who may be more vulnerable to the coronavirus.

Until further notice, ALL Sunday morning Bible classes (all ages), children's worship and activities (including nursery and toddler rooms) will not meet in-house. We ask that kids remain under the supervision of their parents or guardian.

### Worship Options

Our goal is to offer various options for you to worship with us in a way that is safe for you.

1. *Worship with us online from your own home*
  - Our livestream is at 9:30 am on our Facebook page and YouTube channel.
2. *Worship in your vehicle from our church parking lot*
  - Watch our livestream worship service on your own device (9:30 am)  
Note: You may be able to connect to FCC's Wi-Fi
  - Listen on your radio at 87.9 FM (8:00 and 9:30 am)  
Note: This is a short-range signal accessed in close proximity to our church building
3. *Worship in the Worship Center*
  - Two worship services – 8:00 am and 9:30 am
4. *Worship in the Gym*
  - 9:30 am worship service only
  - Recommended for families with children 5<sup>th</sup> grade and under
  - Worship service will be livestreamed on the big screen
  - Tables will be set up for families (one family per table)
  - Age appropriate children's activities will be available at each table

**We ask that you please respect these guidelines.**

### Personal Precautions:

- Anyone who is sick should stay home.
- It is recommended that those who are considered a high risk to the COVID-19 virus should consider a worship option listed above that keeps you safe.
- Please respect the 6' social distancing protocol.
- It is perfectly acceptable to wear a face covering or mask for your own well-being.
- We ask that you not greet one another by shaking hands, hugging, or with a holy kiss.

**General Precautions:**

- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the facility and in each restroom.
- Surfaces where human contact can be made will be sanitized prior to both the 8:00 and 9:30 am worship services.
- Pens and Bibles for guests are available at the Welcome Center upon request. Please keep the pen. We will also give you a Bible to keep. Just ask.
- Drinking fountains will be out-of-service. Bottled water will be available.
- Bulletins will not be available.

**Greeters/Ushers:**

- Greeters will open and close all doors before and after each service, eliminating the need for anyone to touch the door handles. If weather permits, door will be propped open.

**Foyer**

- Please do not linger too long in the foyer before and after the worship service as it can get congested. We encourage people to fellowship outside in order for everyone to be able to maintain a reasonable social distance.

**Restrooms:**

- We ask that no more than two people occupy a restroom at a time.
- Please wash hands before exiting the restroom.
- When exiting restroom, please use a paper towel to open the door, then discard the towel in trash can near the door.

**Seating in the Auditorium:**

- Every other pew will be marked to remain unoccupied. Families/couples or individuals are requested to maintain 6 feet of separation within the same pew from other families/couples or individuals.
- When the service is finished, please maintain social distancing when exiting the back of the Worship Center.

**Communion:**

- Pre-packaged communion emblems will be available as you enter each door of the Worship Center.
- Immediately following observance of the Lord's Supper, deacons will collect the used communion cups.
- Deacons will serve communion in a safe way to those who are in their vehicles in the church parking lot.

**Offering**

- We encourage you to continue to give online using our church app or through your own bank.
- We will not be collecting an offering during the worship service.
- Boxes marked "Offering" will be in the foyer for checks and cash offerings.

**Baptisms**

- We will do our best to accommodate anyone who wishes to be immersed into Christ.
