Camper Discipline Policy

Disruptive behavior will be dealt with in the following manner:

1. One clear warning.
2. The child will be given a timeout. Timeouts can be handled by having the child sit out one minute per age of the child during an activity.
3. If a second timeout is given, then one of their privileges can be taken away such as: one activity, all activities for the day, half or all of the pool session for the day, concession stand, etc. Never take away a lunch privilege or snack privilege.
4. A disciplinary report will be written for the child upon second timeout for same behavior. A disciplinary report will be written along with a first timeout if the offense is severe such as fighting or stealing, etc.
5. First disciplinary report will lead to a conversation with the parents. The second disciplinary report will lead to a meeting with the parent to explain the next consequence of a disciplinary report. The third disciplinary report during the course of the summer will suspend the child for one (1) week from camp. The Camp Director will meet with the parents or guardians before reinstatement.
6. If the child is reinstated and receives a fourth disciplinary report, then the child will be expelled from the camp immediately. Parents will be notified to come pick up the child. The child may not return to camp for the remainder of the summer.
7. If severity is great enough after the first incident, suspension from the program will be effective immediately without following the steps above after Camp Director consults with the Program Director. Parents will be notified.
8. **There will be no corporal punishment.**

Camper Rules and Procedures

1. **No electronic devices!** We want to have a good time unplugged.
2. No foul language (including swear words, stupid, shut up, dummy, idiot, gay, retarded, fatty).
2. Everyone must bring a sack lunch or have a parent bring them lunch.
3. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
4. No name calling or making fun of others.
5. Stay with your group at all times.
6. Follow your leader by listening to what they say.
7. No one will be allowed to go to the restroom alone. A counselor must go with you and wait in the hall. We will have several restroom breaks during the day.
8. No one is allowed near the ditch.
9. Leave other people's property alone.
10. Stay away from the road, cars, and the parking area.
11. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
12. Do not play in or near the water stations.
13. No knives, sharp objects, weapons allowed at camp.
14. No glass containers allowed at camp.
15. No playing around the trees and bushes. Do not destroy any property.
16. **ALL belongings must be taken home on Friday. Nothing is to be left in your cubby on Friday.**
17. Keep the facility CLEAN!
