4KIDS - In the Treasure Coast area, hundreds of children are being removed from their homes each year, but there are not enough foster families in our community. 4KIDS exists to provide loving, Christian homes for these children, keep siblings together, and provide hope and healing to kids and teens.





Care Net - A faith-based, non-profit ministry that challenges youth to make healthy choices and assists families facing unplanned pregnancies



Dunklin Memorial Church - This is a residential, Christcentered program to assist men in overcoming chemical addiction. The 11-month program is where men can be res-

cued (from themselves and their addiction), redeemed (to a right relationship with Jesus, set free from bondage), and restored (to their families and friends) through the message of the gospel.

Fellowship of Christian Athletes - FCA seeks to make disciples through their methods of engaging, equipping, and empowering coaches and athletes to know and grow in Christ and lead others to do the same.



Foster-Church - Located in Washington state, this ECO church plant supports foster families and provides care and protection for vulnerable children.





Good Samaritan Ministries - A faith-based organization committed to helping the homeless, the hurting, and the underprivileged with a residential recovery

program, food pantry, and job training skills

Grandmothers & Others - A sewing fellowship ministry that provides handmade clothing to local children in Martin County





Love and Hope in Action (LAHIA) - Their mission is to reach the hungry, homeless, and hurting. They demonstrate Jesus Christ's love for the homeless and indigent by meeting the basic physical and spiritual needs of all those who come through their doors.

The Refuge Ranch - This Christ-centered approach to recovery empowers women to embrace the journey and experience personal transformation. It is a ministry for adult women that combines biblical teaching with domestic and job-related skills in a supervised home environment.



The Salvation Army (Compassion House) - Inspired by the love of God, the mission of The Salvation Army of Martin County is to touch people with the love and compassion of Jesus Christ, to minister to our community, and to provide for their basic human needs without discrimination. Compassion House offers a safe and secure shelter, meals, clothing, and counseling for residents as they work to once again become self-sufficient.
