1 Chronicles 29:10–20

Today, I want us to focus on the Lord’s gracious generosity towards each of us. What does it look like through the lens of Scripture? As individuals and/or families, how might the Lord be calling us to demonstrate generosity (as a gracious response) to the people and world around us — for God’s glory and the benefit of others? And our response as a community: we echo Scripture and worship with this truth in mind, *“Blessed be the name of the Lord!”*

- **Teaching Point #1:** Throughout the Bible, we find that God is always giving...The Lord is the SOURCE of all things, the Giver of every good and perfect gift.
- **Teaching Point #2:** No temple tax here! Giving generously to the Lord comes from our grateful hearts.
- **Life Application:** Opportunities that we have to give should be a time for rejoicing — for we are generously offering our lives, blessing the Lord as an act of worship!
