Time of Prayer:

1. Pray that God would allow you to see the world around you according to the truth of His word that God's good authority has made humans as male and female in His image.
2. That God would help you see your ultimate identity in Jesus clearly and to live accordingly in praise to Him.
3. For the work of the Holy Spirit to help you to embrace who God has made you in His good authority, and to treat others with compassion.
4. That God would give you clarity on the truth of the Gospel and what it means to bring that truth into the world around you with compassion and clarity.
