Take Away Truth: Jesus is the only way to the Father

Focus Passages:

John 14:1-6

Let not your hearts be troubled. **Believe in God; believe also in me.** In my Father's house there are many rooms. If it were not so, I would have told you that. I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. And you know the way to where I am going." Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "**I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.**"

Discussion Questions

1. Jesus says he is the only way to the Father. What comes to your heart or mind when you think of the fact that Jesus is the only way to Heaven, and the Father? The Bible talks about two ways; the way of life and the way of death. What was it like when you walked in the way that led to death? What does the way of life look like to you now?
2. Jesus is the only truth. The devil is the father of all lies. Today we live in a world filled with messages and many of them are lies. Share something that the devil lied to you and you believed it to be true? How did you discover the real truth? How can you begin sharing the truth with those around you? Would you be willing to pray for the Holy Spirit to help you share the truth of Jesus? What would that prayer look like for you?
3. Jesus said He is the life. The opposite of life is death. Spiritual death is eternal separation from God. Yet Jesus invites us to an abundant life and eternal life with the Father. What was your experience like transitioning from a dead way of living, where everything was self-centered and focused on you, to a life that is alive and free in Jesus? Share your story!
4. Jesus claimed he was God in His statement "I AM". The Jews wanted to stone him, yet he slipped away. Later, when the Roman soldiers came looking for Him, He told them, "I AM He", and they fell to the ground because of His power and authority. Share a time where you experienced Jesus showing up powerful in your life?

Time of Prayer:

Take some time to pray through the prompts below. If you are in a group, assign one to anyone willing and take turns praying together.

- Pray that God the Father would give you boldness to declare that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life of the world.
- Pray that God will give Immanuel Church's shepherds, elders, leaders, volunteers and partners boldness to share the gospel faithfully and with the truth found in Scripture.
