Nico and Darlene Yocca, young married university students, have become involved in La Roca soup kitchen and have brought focus, organization and a great vitality that has renewed the work with the teenagers. They have also been giving carpentry and knitting classes to a group of the mothers.

Martin and Carolina Moyano have taken on the responsibility of leadership in the Huñaj Atum ministry. Every Saturday a team of workers goes out to work with the children, the youth, the adults and serve a warm meal to all. People from different settlements in area are attending and ministry is growing.

Carlos and Elizabeth González have a missionary call and have recently started traveling 260 miles every other week end to a small rural settlement called Villa Matoque in the northern part of Santiago. An abandoned preaching point I travelled to as a short-term missionary many years ago has survived its remoteness and they are helping to grown it into a church.

Carlos and Estrella Acuña have started a church in their part of town and we are partnering with them and working with them in the process.

As we are looking to establish a small group-based ministry we recently took a group of people to a week end workshop on the Timothy Initiative, a church planting movement based o disciples making disciples. Two groups have been started in the city and one in the rural ministry.

As a family we just celebrated our daughter Amy's graduation from the University of Tucumán as a medical veterinary. Our little "sunshine" has grown into a disciplined and responsible hard working adult and the week after graduation was already doing part time substitutions in local veterinaries. The family picture where Amy is all painted up is part of the celebration that professors, classmates and friends carry out after she passed her last exam. Once all "stripped down and painted up" she was put in the back of a pick up and driven around town celebrating with all kinds of sounds and signs, an Argentine tradition!

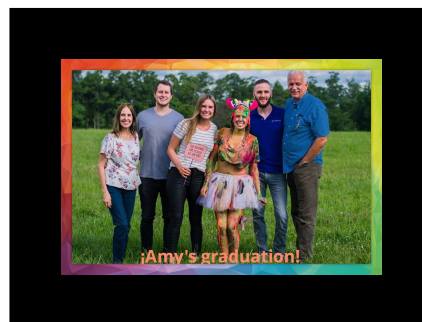
