NH's Commission: Love God. Love Others. Make Disciples.

Q1. What's the purpose of Christ's Church?

A: The purpose of Christ's Church is to Love God, Love Others & Make Disciples.

Matthew 22:36–40 "Jesus said: 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and love your neighbor as yourself.'"

Matthew 28:19–20 "Jesus said, 'Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.'"

Q2. What's a disciple?

A: A disciple follows Jesus, is being changed by Jesus, & joins Jesus in making disciples.

Matthew 4:19 "Jesus said, 'Come, follow Me, and I will make you fish for people.'"

Q3. How do we make disciples?

A: We make disciples like Jesus did: Intentionally, Relationally & Biblically.

Mark 4:33-34 "With many parables Jesus spoke the Word to the crowds. But when He was alone with His disciples, He explained everything."

Q4. What's the role of the Holy Spirit in making disciples?

A: The Holy Spirit is the Chief Disciple-Maker.

John 14:26 "Jesus said, 'The Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My Name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.'"

Q5. What's a helpful way to engage with God and others using the Bible?

A: "Head, Heart & Hands" the Scriptures.

HEAD. What is God teaching us?

HEART. What is God speaking to us?

HANDS. What is God calling us to do in response?

Matthew 4:4 "Jesus answered, 'It is written: "Humankind does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"
