Baby care items for maternity wards

- *Lightweight blankets, onesies, wipes (small packages), pacifiers.*

First Aid supplies for local families

- *Band-Aids, AAA antibiotic, latex gloves, generic meds: Ibuprofen (Advil, etc.), Acetaminophen (Tylenol, etc.), anti-diarrhea meds, (Imodium, etc.)*

Women's grooming products

- *Hand lotion (small bottles), lip balm, hair ties & clips, razors, emery boards.*

Personal hygiene items

- *Deodorant (solid only), bars of soap, shampoo (small bottles), toothbrush, toothpaste, floss, razors, hand sanitizer (small bottles).*

Small toys for elementary-age children

- *Deflated kickballs & soccer balls, Frisbees, Hot Wheels cars, miniature dolls, small plastic animal figures, jump ropes, yo-yos, sidewalk chalk, hacky sacks, temporary tattoos, small coloring books & small crayon packs.*

Building supplies

- *Wall switches & faceplates, duplex wall outlets & faceplates, plastic electrical boxes, wire nuts, work gloves.*

Other

- *Gallon & quart Ziplock bags, AAA, AA, 9v. batteries.*
