Immersed is the perfect word to capture the fantastically great blessings communicated to us in the book of Romans: God has made it possible for us to no longer be separated from Him, but rather, to be permanently and irrevocably "in Christ!"

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. (Romans 6:3-4)

Several deep thinkers I consulted regarding this passage agree that what is spoken of here is not less than water baptism, but it is more. This text communicates the amazing reality that in some spiritual manner, our old sinful selves have been absorbed into the death of Christ, and we are now resurrected to be alive with Him, never again to be subject to death (just as He is not) and never again to be separated from Him for all eternity! Can I get an Amen!?

All of this is an indescribable gift of God – not in response to anything we have done or deserve, but completely out of the benevolence of His heart. This is what it means to be "immersed in grace." We are not sprinkled with grace – we are saturated in it. Not dribbled but drenched. Not teased but fully satisfied. I have been super encouraged to watch what I can only describe as a movement of God's Spirit among our church family this year as we have immersed ourselves in Paul's letter to the Romans. In my time at Grace Point, I've never seen such deep engagement in a sermon series, such enthusiasm for the truths that are surfacing, such moving evidence that people are putting their faith into action.

As you read this annual report, let's celebrate together what GOD is graciously doing in our church family! I'm so glad our first name as a faith community is "Grace." May we never lose sight of the incredible, undeserved good which God has poured out on us, and may we not dabble but drench ourselves in the riches He has made available as we learn to live "in Christ!"

What a joy celebrating our Great King with a medieval theme and a focus on the armor of God during the 2023 Vacation Bible School! The last time Grace Point did VBS was in 2019. Because of the pandemic and changes in the leadership of Children's Ministry, we did not have a full VBS until this year. What an encouragement to see so many excited to be a part of it!

Throughout the week, we had 95 kids laughing, dancing, worshiping, learning, making crafts, and playing games. About 30% of the kids who attended do not currently attend Grace Point However, several of them decided to join us for VBS after having a great time at Family Fun Fest. It was amazing to see kids thrilled each night to be a part of VBS. One of the most exciting portions of the evening was during our opening and closing ceremonies. We held a coin competition where teams raced to see who could bring the most coins to support School of Hope in Lebanon. We raised a total of \$574.71. We packed in the fun, as each evening kids participated in games, crafts, lesson time, and ended the night with a drama.

One thing that was really encouraging throughout the week was to see the way that kids responded to the lesson

time. Many had thoughtful comments and questions as they explored the Gospel, truth and the armor of God. It seemed that we could never have enough time, as kids always wanted to dive deeper into God's Word.

Possibly the biggest blessing was seeing how the church came together to help make VBS a reality. More than 70 people were involved in many different capacities. While an evening VBS is not always ideal, one thing was apparent: it allowed many more people to be involved in a variety of areas. Each night before VBS, Women's Ministry partnered with us to host a volunteer dinner, to help ease the transition from work to church. What a blessing to look around and see so many fellowshipping and preparing to serve!

The week wrapped up with a Celebration Service on Sunday morning. What a gift to be able to invite back families who were new to our church, as well as share with the entire congregation the blessing that VBS was for many! We will continue to celebrate and praise our Great King for the work He did in hearts during VBS 2023.
