SAMMinistries provides assistance through programs that HELP those on the brink of becoming homeless through prevention and rapid re-housing programs; offer HOPE to those currently homeless through wrap-around support services such as employment assistance, educational scholarships, children’s programs, and in-kind items; and provide a HOME to those moving away from homelessness through transitional and permanent supportive housing programs. SAMMinistries knows what works to overcome the impact of homelessness on individuals, families, and the community at large.
