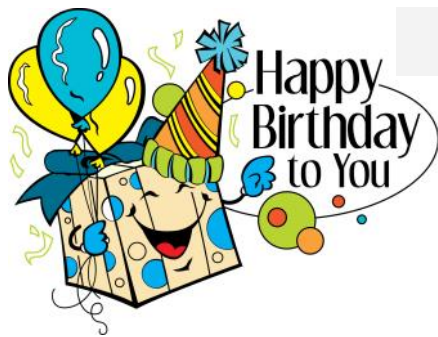
Pastor is very excited to invite you to join him for an evening of great food and meaningful conversation.

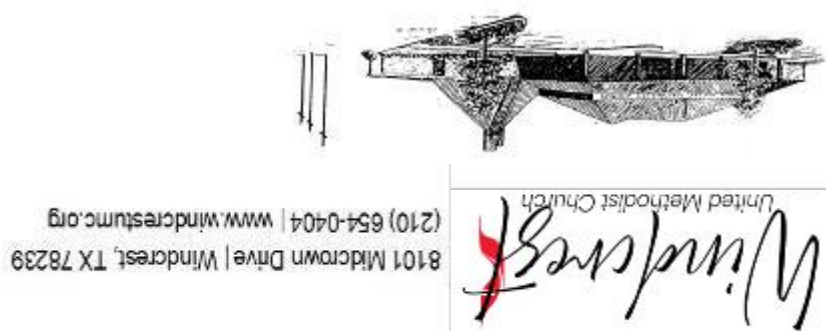
