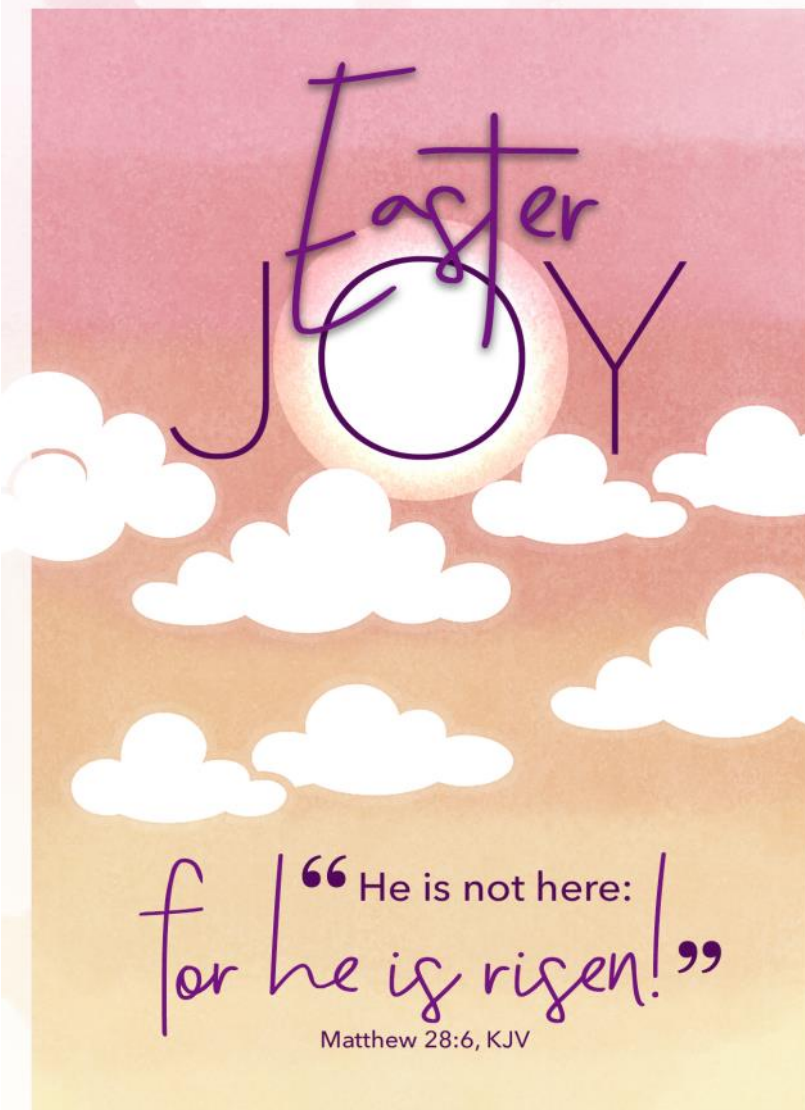

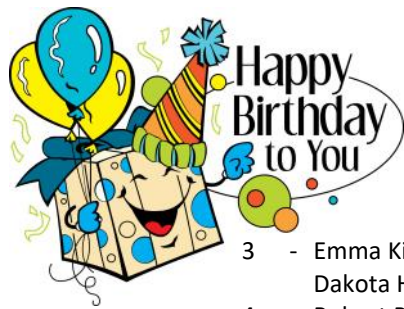
Saturday, April 25, 2026, 5:00 pm


Lost and FOUND!!!!

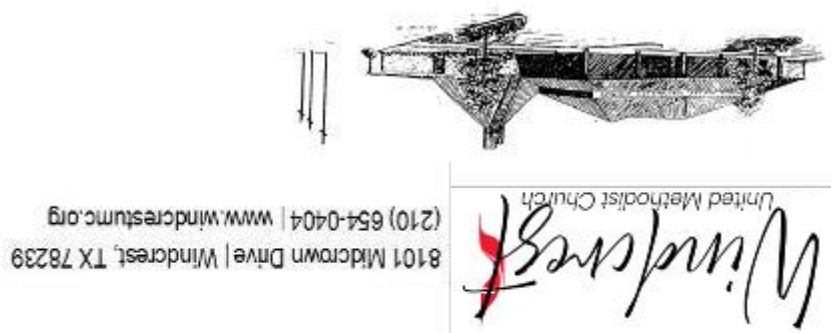
Windcrest Day School
