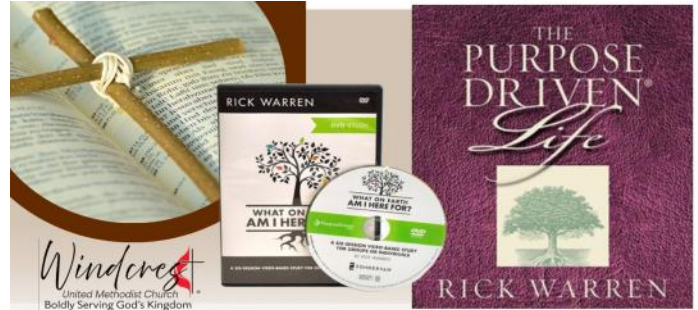

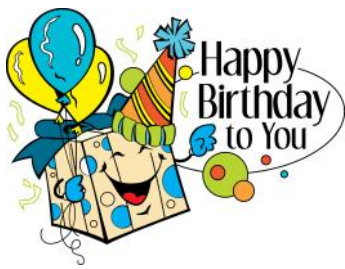
## **On-break during the Summer months**

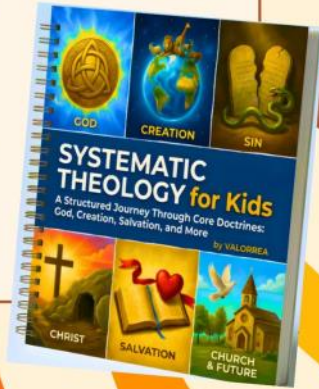

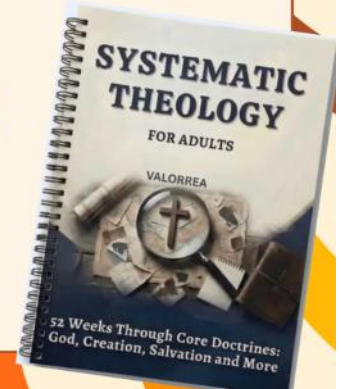

## Sensory Room

We are happy to share that over the next month, our current Cry Room will be transformed into a designated Sensory Room. This space is designed to offer a calm, supportive environment for individuals with sensory sensitivities so they can participate more fully in worship. While this room will be comfortable and soothing, please remember that it is not a playroom, but a worship space.

Our Sensory Room can be especially helpful for those who may become overstimulated by bright lights, loud music, or crowded spaces. The goal is not to separate anyone from our church family, but to provide a temporary, safe place where individuals can regulate their senses, reduce anxiety, and then rejoin the service when they are ready. Families with children who have autism, ADHD, or other sensory processing challenges may find this space particularly helpful, allowing them to attend services without leaving early or feeling excluded.

Our hope is that this sensory room will ensure everyone has the opportunity to fully participate in worship.

Please note:

- All children must be supervised at all times by a parent or guardian.
- No food or drinks will be allowed in this space.

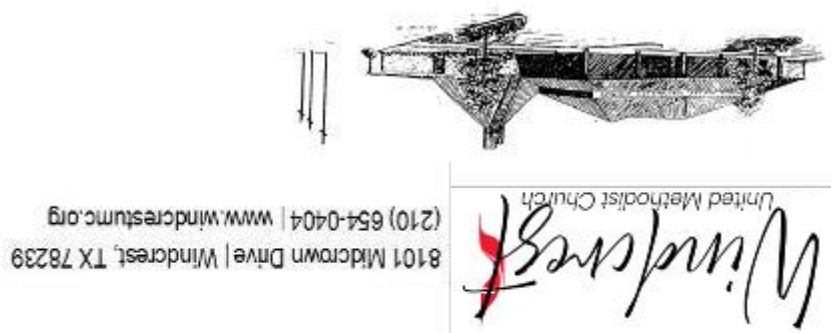
