Upcoming Wellness Event – Saturday, March 28, 2026

Windcrest UMC will be hosting a wellness fair from 10:00 am-2 pm on Saturday, March 28. The event will take place in the front parking lot off Walzem Rd and is being hosted in conjunction with New Creation Christian Fellowship and Now Word Covenant Church.

The Women’s Education and Health Retreat (WEHR) is a 501c3 non-profit organization that is organizing this event at WUMC. The event is open to all men, women and children – with or without insurance. We expect hundreds of people to attend during those four hours. Our target audience is the under-insured, low-income, unhoused and underserved brothers and sisters in our community. There will be NO CHARGE to them for medical, dental and optical services and many vendors will be providing information and assistance in other areas such as nutrition, financial, self-care, family services and employment opportunities. Attendees can receive a free meal, and the San Antonio Food Bank will deliver food that we will distribute to attendees as well.

Many volunteers are needed to host an event of this size! Some work – such as connection with the wider community via outreach and preparing registration bags can be done prior to the actual event. Other tasks such as set-up and tear down of vendor booths, breaking down and distribution food bank items, directing traffic, and guiding attendees to various vendor specific booths are needed the day of the event. Please see our volunteer coordinator, Dan Reese, if you can volunteer to help in any way.

Please go to the website <https://www.wellnesscentersa.com> or click on the QR code below to pre-register as a volunteer and/or attendee. Someone will be available in the Gathering Place before each Sunday worship service to answer your questions and assist you if you need help registering online. Everyone is welcome to attend and visit the vendors for specific information they may be seeking. We just need to know the number of attendees coming because of food considerations. I hope we can count on you to volunteer to help make this a good, welcoming experience. When everything is all said and done, people will remember what they experienced here at Windcrest UMC during the event, not necessarily the words WEHR wellness promotion. Let’s work together as a church community to make our church the loving and welcoming place we all know and love!

Pastor is very excited to invite you to join him for an evening of great food and meaningful conversation.

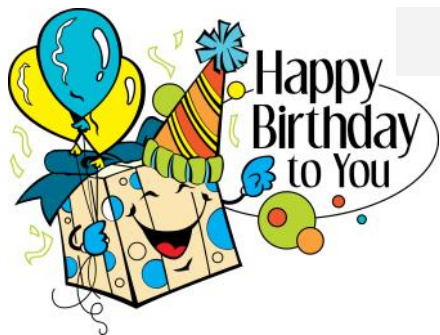

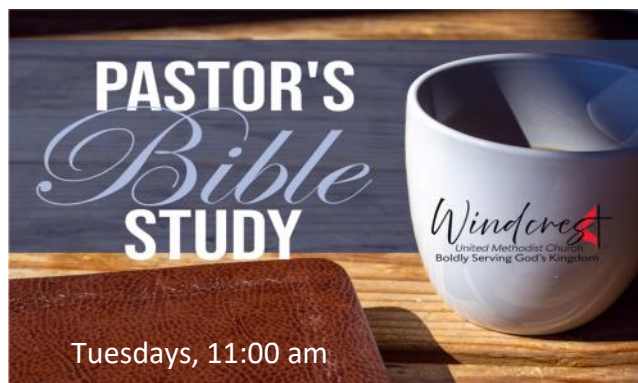

Music Notes

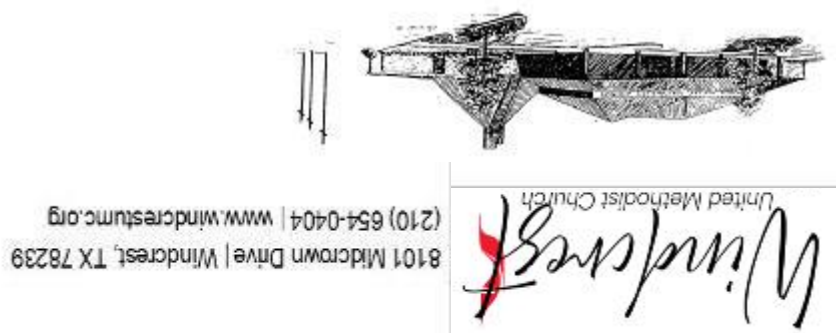
