### Joyful Ringers

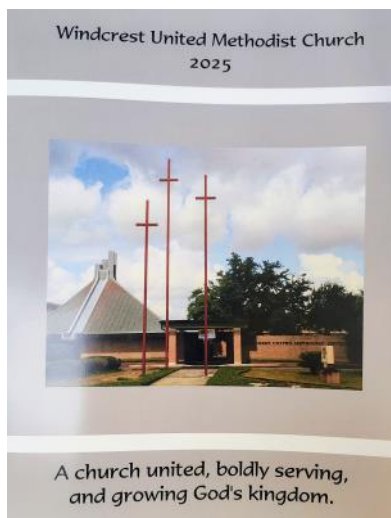

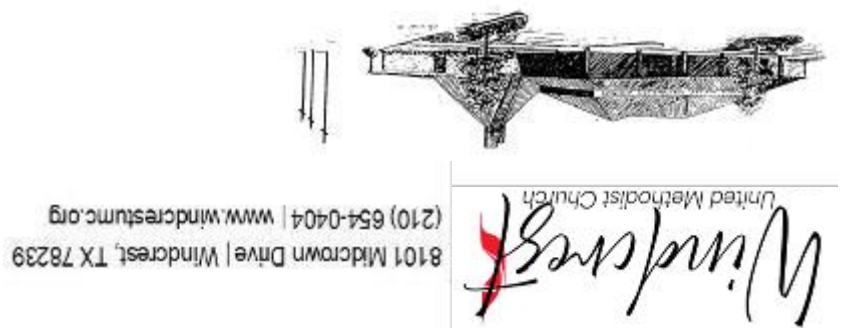
