
Great Communications at Work!!!

From Pastor Robert Waddle

Focusing on Jesus is the key to joy, even during times of distress.

Philippians 1:1-8

The apostle Paul demonstrated that spiritual joy is possible even during times of adversity. In fact, his epistle to the Philippians, written during a time of imprisonment, is known for its repeated references to rejoicing. But have you ever felt as if you've lost your joy? This can happen for several reasons:

• Wrong focus. By centering on Jesus, Paul was able to praise God despite harsh trials. Concentrating on difficulties can cause delight to vanish. Refocus through praise to bring it back.



- Disobedience. Sin steals our joy because it disrupts our fellowship with God (Ps. 66:18). As we receive His forgiveness and obey Him, joy returns.
- Regret. We crowd out gladness when we dwell on past mistakes. The Lord has forgiven us (1 John 1:9). He wants us to choose to live in His grace and move ahead.
- Fear. Joy and fear cannot coexist. We are called to live by faith, asking God to meet today's needs and trusting Him with the future.
- Others' suffering. How can we rejoice when others hurt? Romans 12:15 says we're to weep with them, but we are also to offer the hope of God's presence, power, and provision.

A consistently downcast spirit is a poor witness for hope (Ps. 42:11). Fix your gaze on the Savior and let His joy become yours. Then it can overflow to those around you.

I pray that every eye that reads this knows there is no problem, no circumstance or situation greater than God; and I pray that these words be received into the hearts of every eye that sees it in Jesus' name. Amen!

Thank you Lord for your grace and mercy!

As we enter the fall of the year hopefully the weather will be cooler(lol) lots of rain. Let's focus on the joys of life, let us not worry about things we can't change and focus on Christ who can change all things. Watch our stress level decrease and our spiritual life increase.

September—Neighbors Helping Neighbors

This "food ministry" is a direct response to the calling in the Gospel of Matthew, "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink..." Matthew 25:35.

This verse reminds us that serving those in need is not just an act of kindness but a reflection of our faith in action.

Those serving in this ministry, whatever way you serve, with prayers, financial contributions, donations for our Pantry, and/or encouraging words, helps NHN meet the challenges each month AND receive the blessings bestowed upon each and everyone.

This month, NHN is placed in the spotlight to inform you of what has been happening every Thursday on our church campus. AND to thank you for your continued support.

We have added additional days, two (2) Wednesdays a month where volunteers are available to receive LARGE amounts of food AT NO COST to our Pantry from the San Antonio Food Bank. What a perfect fit this is for our increasing numbers each week because these new programs are also helping with grocery rescue from the retail grocery stores to prevent food waste. It's a WIN WIN! With this added service, we DO need additional volunteers particularly in the area of receiving TONS of food on Wednesdays.

We have more details to share with you regarding this faith in action and we will do so on Sunday, August 31! In closing, here are some of the reasons volunteers at your weekly WUMC Pantry and the SA Food Bank truck do what they do.....every Thursday!

As you can see, the Music Department is busy. Thank you for supporting us. We're always recruiting new members to our programs, so if you would like to join us, please do!


