

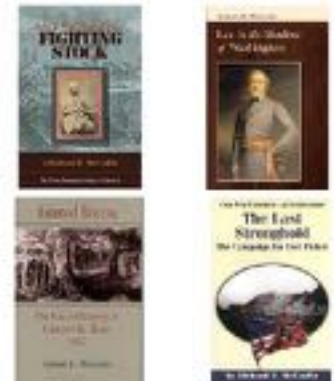

Dr. McCaslin is the TSHA Endowed Professor of Texas History at UNT and author of 18 books. His works have received the Laney Prize & Slatten Award, Pulitzer nomination, Tullis Prize and AASLH commendation, Award Merit from the Texas Philosophical Society, Pate Award, Bates Award and numerous others. He is a Fellow of the Texas State Historical Association and Admiral in the Texas Navy.

Italian sculptor, Coppini, came to Texas in 1901 to create bronze sculptures for the Confederate monuments at the Capitol. He stayed and became the darling of heritage organizations, who hired him to create Texas memorials all over the state. His creations are some of the best known public art. Coppini left a legacy that defined the historic landscape in Texas for generations.
