**THE FOCUS FOR NOVEMBER IS PRAYER!**

### **WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE**

**SUNDAY:** Pray for the children and their families who receive a shoe box gift, that hearts will be opened to the Good News of Jesus Christ.

**MONDAY:** Most children who receive shoe box gifts live in desperate circumstances. Pray that God will meet their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.

**TUESDAY:** Pray for our ministry partners in countries around the world, especially that the shoe box gifts and follow-up discipleship programs will be effective evangelism tools.

**WEDNESDAY:** Pray the doors will be opened, so that the Good News can be shared in countries that are not receptive to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**THURSDAY:** Pray for those who fill shoe box gifts this year, especially for children, that they will see that it is truly more blessed to give than to receive.

**FRIDAY:** Pray for those involved in collecting, processing, transporting, and delivering shoe box gifts, including the tens of the thousands of volunteers.

**SATURDAY:** Pray for the Samaritan's Purse staff located throughout the world as they handle the logistics of Operation Christmas Child.
