We should judge the success of preaching based on its faithfulness to God's Word and not on whether we "enjoyed" it or not. I think that is the point of 2 Timothy 4:3 *For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear.* Often God tells us what we don't want to hear in order to tell us what we NEED to hear. Someone once said that in the beginning God created mankind in His own image and we have been returning the favor ever since. Let be quick to listen to God's Word even when it doesn't say what our ears want to hear.
