- C. Your desires give focus to service.
- D. Your skills bring quality to service.
- E. Your education brings competence to service.
- F. Your personality expresses itself in service.
- G. Your experiences help develop you for service.
- H. Your love determines the long-lasting impact of your service.
- I. Your joy and spiritual fruit suggest God's blessing upon your service.

***Questions to consider:***

- 4) "What has God done in the past through you in your life and at FBC?"
- 5) "What is God doing through you in the present in your life and at FBC?"
- 6) "What do you believe to be God's plans for you and for FBC? Will you join Him?"
- 7) "Based on your past experiences, your current circumstances, and your future hopes and goals, what is the wise thing for you to do next?"

Let the following two questions help develop your application as you ponder and pray...

- As you reflect on your answers to A-I and 1-7, answer the following: "What seems impossible today, yet, if it could be done, would fundamentally and positively benefit the Kingdom of God and bring God glory?"
- Then, "With **all** things considered, if I could design a specific way to serve God around what I understand of **His** will and how **He** has made me—and if I knew I couldn't fail—*this* is what I would attempt to do with and for God with my life..."

Remember: God does not always call the qualified, *He typically qualifies the called: that's the "on the job training" that discipleship achieves!!*
