Enrollment for 2026/2027

Re-enrollment for the 2026/2027 school year will begin in March. The program options available will be:

For potty trained 3-year-olds

- 2 days per week - T-Th
- 3 days per week - MWF

For 4-year-olds

- We offer two Junior Kindergarten classes, both M-F
- For children who will be turning 5 years old
- For children who would benefit from a third year of preschool
- For children who miss the cut-off date to go to kindergarten
- Placement determined by age, emotional readiness, and teacher recommendations
