# Halloween at FNS

Halloween at FNS is fun and simple; we'll enjoy a special Halloween snack and we'll go on a parade! Here's the plan:

- At 11:45 a.m., just before pick-up time, we'll go on a Halloween Parade for parents!
  Please arrive before 11:45 to line up around the outside of the fence. The kids will parade around the inside of the fence and when they've returned to their classroom, you may line up and sign your child out as you normally do.
- The Halloween parade for Classroom A will be on Thursday, October 30<sup>th</sup>.
- The Halloween parade for Classroom B, Classroom C and Classroom D will be on Friday, Oct. 31st.
- Children in Classroom C and Classroom D, our 4/5-year-olds, may wear their costume or Halloween themed clothing. Please, nothing spooky and nothing that covers their face!
- Children in Classroom A and Classroom B, our 3-year-olds, will make a special headband during class time to wear for their parade but they won't wear a costume because it's too difficult to get off when they need to go potty. It's perfectly ok for kids to wear Halloween themed clothing though!
- To protect costumes and headbands, we'll play in the gym on parade days.
- Look for a sign-up sheet outside your child's class for ways that you can help with a special Halloween snack.
