

RE-GATHERING PHASE 4

Sunday Services:

Phase 4 of Re-Gathering at Lakeview provides an opportunity for live worship along with the “live-streaming” of our services for those who are worshipping from home.

We are starting with a 9:00 am Sunday service and if need and resources allow, we will look toward adding either an additional space for viewing in the building at the same time, and/or consider adding another service.

We are continuing to follow the guidelines established in Phase 3 for reservations and cleaning procedures along with general COVID protocols for social distancing, face coverings, entering, and exiting. Occupancy limitations will be increased during this phase to up to 50% capacity.

- Up to 20 minutes of “live” worship is possible with a maximum of two vocalists each week. All other musicians will wear masks and be spaced per guidelines set up in Phase 3.
- The pastor, worship leader, and others may remove their masks while engaged in leading the service, provided they are able to maintain a distance of at least 12 feet from others present. They will replace their face covering when they are not up front.

We are now welcoming all families with children to worship with us. We will seat families with young children in a designated space in the sanctuary as much as possible.

Children in Worship

- We recommended that children ages two-four years wear a mask. We will require masks for those 5 years and older.
- There will be a take-home bag of items provided for each child to use and then take home after the service, or parents can bring other appropriate activities for their children.
- Families have the option to reserve table-seating at the back of the sanctuary.
- The Family Room is available for families to reserve during the service/s. (Only one family per worship service and reservations are expected)

We have designated bathrooms available for use on Sunday mornings. You will be asked to social-distance if there is someone else in the room and/or you may have to wait your turn out in the hallway. The water fountains will not be available for use.

If Lakeview learns that an individual positive with COVID-19 attended a service or group, we will advise the people that they likely came in contact with and will have the maintenance staff will do a deep cleaning and disinfecting consistent with the CDC guidance:

Children’s Ministry options are being rolled out as teachers are found and the space is ready for use.

- **Kidz Korner:** We are offering a limited, by reservation only, children’s ministry program for children age 4 through 5th grade during the 9:00 am service. We will add other classes as the need and our resources allow.

- Children will be grouped in families and will need to wear a mask and be able to follow directions.
- No snacks will be offered.
- Each family will have a separate box/bag of supplies to use.

Family Watch Party: We will consider offering an option for families to watch the live streamed service on-site with other families when the need arises for more family space. This room will be set up with tables and be available with reservations only. A take-home bag of items will be provided for each child.

Nursery:

We will not be offering childcare for infants or toddlers at this time.
