A charitable, non-profit organization, Hidden Acres is a peaceful gathering place where diverse groups of people experience life-giving connections with God, one another, and nature.



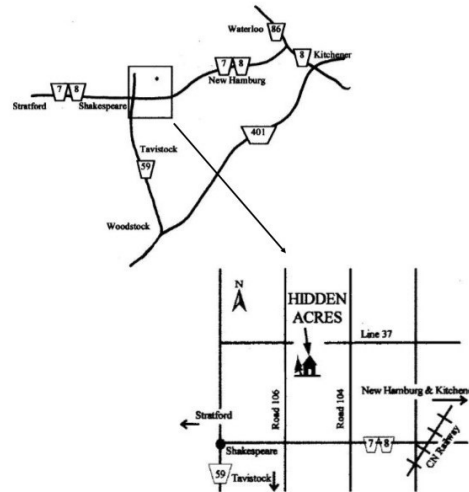

About the Retreat

What is Medical Assistance in Dying, (MAID)? What are the choices we have? What are the implications of these choices? How does our faith intersect with how we choose to live and die? What is palliative care? Dr. Taylor will share the current status of Canada's MAID legislation, including the process of applying for MAID and the procedure itself, as well as some tools that individuals, their families and POAs can use to promote better conversations around end of life decision-making. Through anonymized stories from Dr. Taylor and our afternoon panel participants led by Jane Kuepfer, we hope to better understand and appreciate the role that MAID and intentional end-of-life conversations can make in helping us achieve peace in our final days.

Dr. Martha Taylor graduated from Medical School at Queen's University in 1986. She practiced full spectrum "Cradle to Grave" family medicine for over 30 years and started doing Medical Assistance in Dying work shortly after the law (Bill C-14) was passed, and currently her sole clinical work is in MAID.



Jane Kuepfer, RP, PhD, MDiv, is the Schlegel Specialist in Spirituality and Aging with the Schlegel-US Research Institute for Aging and Conrad Grebel University College. She is a spiritual director, an ordained minister, and a registered psychotherapist, and serves as a spiritual care provider in a retirement home.
