We have been so busy this year! We transitioned into a new denomination (The Global Methodist Church), chose our new names (Trinity Global Methodist Church and North Union Church), and changed our names on all of our bills (thank you Nancy Eberle for making all those phone calls). The work is not done yet! We are in the process of changing signs to reflect our new names and also in the process of doing some necessary repairs this year. Amid all these exciting changes, God has been moving in our church. We saw one person accept Jesus as her Lord and Savior and eight people join our church on Easter, and we witnessed one baptism this past Sunday. We also had some first-time visitors checking out our church.

Looking back on our journey, I noticed how God has provided for all of our needs. We had big fees to pay for our disaffiliation, but God has provided for both churches for such a time as this. At Trinity, we were gifted some money from Tim Rolsten. At North Union, we had an opportunity to sell part of our land to the state for the possibility of expanding Route 127. Then there was the issue of replacing our roof at Trinity. We saw the need for a metal roof that would eliminate constant maintenance costs due to strong winds in our area. God has provided the money for that as well. Lastly, we needed to spend money on our new signage at Trinity – for our new name on the exterior walls and for a new digital sign. Through the work of the Holy Spirit and your generous donations, we are very close in fundraising all that money. Three expensive back-to-back-to back projects, and three times God has graciously provided. I believe that God has provided for those needs so that we can continue our witness to our community of Van Wert. God is not done with Trinity and North Union. God has big plans for us, and I'm excited to be part of Trinity and North Union!

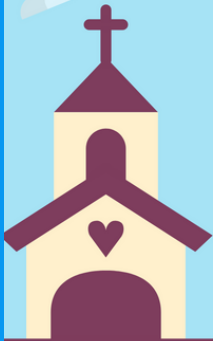

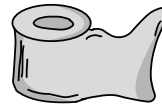


Mission News

Mission Aviation Fellowship – Nampa, ID



A big chunk of my time over the last year has been the addition of two type-specific flight simulators to the training department. I was able to visit the factory a couple of times to make sure these were the right tools for the job, and MAF eventually put deposits down to make the purchase. As is often the case these days, the delivery date was postponed multiple times over the next 6-8 months. The delays weren't the factory's fault; the pandemic led to an FAA backlog that held up the final certification. Finally, after much anticipation, they arrived mid-January. God's timing is perfect, and the simulators showed up just in time for our annual Instructor Pilot Seminar where they were put to work right away. These new tools will allow us to train our pilots in a much safer and standardized way, allowing us to practice emergencies and other maneuvers that are not safe to do in the actual aircraft. Since January, we've spent many hours working through scenarios and developing new curriculum which will make these simulators a vital part of what we do here. We praise the Lord for His amazing provision of the funding for these tools.

TRAVELING ONCE AGAIN ... TO SPAIN! What a joy it was for Scott to travel once again to Spain, our home for 38 years, from March 1-14. Having lived here in the U.S. now for two and a half years, it was great to be back in a country that feels so familiar, yet different now because we no longer live there. Scott has been assigned as the church multiplication facilitator for the Peace and Hope network of churches in Spain, which entails visits once or twice a year, encouraging and facilitating the ministry in any way he can.

ALSO TRAVELING ... TO MEXICO! We have had the privilege of traveling to many places in Europe but never to our neighbor to the south. Kathy will be joining a team with three other women for an OMS-related Dynamic Women in Missions trip to La Piedad, Mexico, April 23 - May 2. They will be training a group of women who have participated in Seed-Sower training (evangelism and disciple-making course) on how to train others in the Seed Sower material. Most of the people at the Nueva Vida (New Life) network we relate to here in Indiana are from Mexico, so it is special to have the opportunity to visit their beautiful country and experience their culture first-hand.

BACK AT HOME Scott really enjoys working with the Global Ministries leadership team in all things administrative and assisting executive director Chris Williams where needed. It is such a privilege to have a part in facilitating the ministries of our missionaries and partners overseas as they seek to reach others for Christ in this spiritually dark world. It is encouraging to see new people coming to Nueva Vida (New Life) Church here in Indianapolis. A daughter church plant is planned for this year. The network itself has grown to over 60 churches with over 3,000 in weekly attendance, not only in the U.S. but in a number of Spanish-speaking countries overseas. The focus is on discipleship, outreach, and leadership development. We thank God for the privilege of being a part of this ministry. Relating to so many Spanish speakers has definitely helped us in our transition from Spain!

Banquet Fundraiser Results



What an unforgettable evening we had at our 8th annual medical banquet fundraiser! We are incredibly blessed to be centered in the most generous, compassionate, and caring community! Your hearts for the work we do is evident, and we appreciate you all so much. Once again, we had a record attendance – over 260 – and exceeded our goal. Over \$98,000 was raised after banquet expenses! We continue to be in awe of how God works through His

people!

At our banquet, we had the opportunity to share our 2022 statistics to give people a chance to see how the funds we receive impact those we serve. Continue to pray for us as we share the love of Christ through the PLCHC ministry.

Patients Served: 285 new patients, 86 pregnancy tests performed, 148 ultrasounds performed, 61 STI tests performed, 13 babies born

Learn and Earn Services: 34 educational patients served, 291 classes attended, 3 dads attending regularly with patient, 1235 items provided from our Baby Boutique

Decisions and Spiritual Impact: 322 patients introduced to the gospel message of Jesus, 139 Bible studies held, 2 abortion-minded moms carried and delivered because of our services (and maybe more of which we are unaware)

In-School/Teen Services: 350 BLUE program participants, 673 PINK program participants, 4 teen support patients served
