

### **6 Tips for Welcoming New Guests at Our Church**

We have had a lot of new guests come to Trinity in August! When compared to July, our attendance has increased by 32 people! This is an exciting time to welcome and invite our guests to be part of our church, and as we do so, here are 6 tips for being more welcoming at both Trinity & North Union:

#### 1. Park far away

Every time we go to a new place, like to a restaurant or store we have not been to before, don't we dread the parking the most? We can see where the entrance is, but if we can't even park and get out of our cars, we give up and move on. It is very intimidating to go to a new church and try to find a good parking spot. To be a good host (if we are able), let us park further away from the main entrance to allow closer parking for our guests and for those who can't walk far.

#### 2. Say hi but don't talk too long

It is overwhelming being in a new place and seeing new people. If we are the guests, and we are stopped 10 times to give our whole life story, that's too much. One to two minutes of talking is sufficient. If the guests want to talk more, that's fine.

#### 3. Ask if you can help them

Our new guests are lost at times and don't know where to go or what to do. If you see someone who looks puzzled, ask if you can help them. Maybe they're looking for the restrooms, coffee, or the children's area. Ask if you can help them, and then....

### 4. Walk them to where they need to go

Instead of giving directions or pointing to where they need to go, offer to walk them there. Walk them to the bathroom, to the coffee area, to the children's area, to a pew to get ready for service, etc.

#### 5. Sit somewhere else

If you walk into the sanctuary and see someone sitting where you usually sit, sit somewhere else. You can sit beside them, beside a friend, or somewhere new. The worst thing you can do to upset our guests is to tell them that they are sitting in your seat. It's not your seat. It belongs to God who owns this whole world. So, we share His building, His sanctuary, and His pews with each other and with our guests.

#### 6. Invite them to come back

As we leave the worship service and see our guests before they exit, invite them to come back. Tell them that it was so wonderful to see them this morning and to please come back next Sunday. Invite them to sit with you next time if they want. That way, they would feel more comfortable coming back because they would be sitting with someone who just became their friend!










### YWCA's "Scarf Bombing" and Wassenberg's "Warm Up the Ridge"
