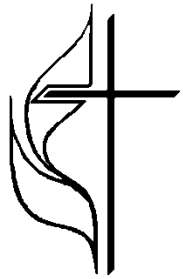

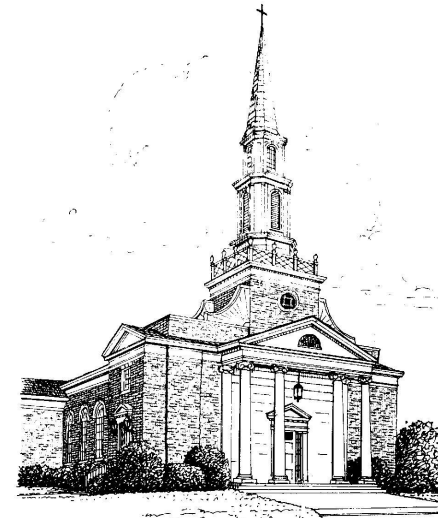
The children will be singing on Sunday, May 19th, at the 11:00 a.m. service.
