This scholarship is open to anyone graduating high school and older, up to and including senior citizens. This scholarship is for any continuing education classes. This is a merit scholarship. It is not awarded for financial need. Applications may be made yearly. If a person is awarded money in one calendar year, he/she can reapply the following year. However, preference may be given to new applicants.

If awarded scholarship funds, you will be contacted for payment information. The scholarship(s) is paid directly to the school or institution.

Applications are available on the website, by email, or in the Church office and must be submitted by Friday, April 17, 2026, in order to be considered.
