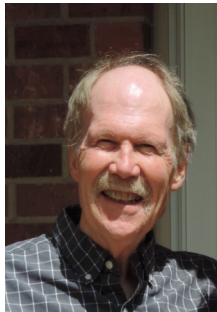

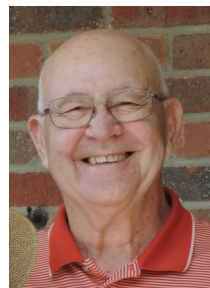
DEACONS
